our periodontal service

We live in strange times, particularly economically. I am aware of the financial constraints our patients are under and that we all have priorities to fulfill such as mortgage payments and our children's education.

I am also aware that as yet, there is no cure for periodontal disease and that if the disease is not identified and dealt with early enough, then problems are inevitable further down the line.

Periodontal diseases remain the primary cause for tooth loss in this country. Unfortunately, the defence societies continue to inform us that untreated periodontal disease remains the largest area of concern for them and results in the greatest number of cases requiring settlement. Additionally, more and more cases of failed implant therapy are coming to light too, particularly in those patients who have had a history of periodontal disease.

I am often asked the question - 'why didn't my dentist send me earlier' when I see patients who need extensive treatment or worse still, need to have teeth out because they are beyond viable therapy. I am therefore writing to inform you of new initiatives here at the Centre which I hope will help you with regards to what to do with your periodontal patients.

Referral Guidelines

I continue to use the BPE guidelines for who and when to refer. A copy is enclosed for you to keep, which I hope will prove to be helpful.

As stated, cost is proving to be a difficult hurdle to overcome. I fully appreciate this, particularly when the patients are told they have a condition that is 'not causing them any problems' and that there is the likelihood that it will cost them

a significant amount of money to rectify. I would still encourage a referral as it is very likely that the situation will get worse, ultimately costing a lot more time and money.

The key message is to refer as early as possible as this will ensure that you are covered from a medico-legal viewpoint. It is also important to ensure that a periodontal opinion has been given prior to any extensive treatments such as bridgework, orthodontics and implant therapy.

Fee Guide

Many of you have asked for an idea of the fees charged for treatments carried out here. I feel that transparency of the fees I charge is essential and have listed below my fee guide for your convenience. In view of the economic downturn, fees have not increased here at the practice for some time. In fact, I have decided to reduce a number of the fees to make the treatment more affordable, especially to those who need the treatment most.

Courses

As you may know, I am running a course later this year at the Moor Training Centre, specifically for hygienists and therapists, where the aim is to consolidate the message so that patients can benefit from a 'team approach'. I am certain that this strategy will result in motivated, healthy and happy patients. I therefore encourage those of you who have
